2. **Reference and Referral Services:** Each year the OEN fields hundreds of environmentally-related inquiries from media, members of the public, government, and others, and re-directs these information requests to our members.
3. **Delegate Selection:** The OEN is called upon by both the private and public sectors to identify delegates representing the environmental non-profit sector to participate in consultations or on advisory committees. Members of our OEN member groups are eligible for delegate selection processes at the national level.
4. **Member Discounts on Goods and Services:** The OEN is pleased to offer discounted rates to OEN members on Group Insurance Rates. Our plan is a bundle of low cost insurance products including Director's and Officers Liability, General Liability, and Employee Benefits packages for groups with one or more employees.
